Credit System

CFU are the Italian equivalent of **ECTS** (European Credit Transfer System): 1 CFU = 1 ECTS.

1 CFU = 25 hours of workload

- lectures and other forms of instruction
- assignments and independent work

~30 CFU

usually achieved in 1 semester (60 CFU per year)

Grading System

Exams in Italy are graded using a **scale of 30**, where 18 is the minimum passing grade.

• Excellent: from 27/30 to 30/30 cum laude

• **Good**: from 24/30 to 26/30

• Satisfactory: from 21/30 to 23/30

• Barely passing: from 18/30 to 20/30

• **Fail**: from 0 to 17/30

Training Courses > Safety Courses

School of Design students are required to take 2 online safety courses:

Basic Course on Safety

The Online **Basic Course on Safety** is **compulsory for every student** at Polimi.

You won't be able to register to exams if you don't pass it before.

Course to access the Design Labs

This certificate is required to **gain** access to the Design Department Labs and to use the equipment.

We recommend taking this course promptly to participate in lab activities from the very beginning.

Training Courses > Safety Courses

You can access the required courses by following this path:

Online Services > Data > Training Courses > Courses on Safety.



Basic Course on Safety:

<u>Recipients</u>: teaching staff, contract professors, temporary research fellows, undergraduates and PhD students, technical-administrative personnel and collaborators.

This course - lasting the equivalent of 4 hours - corresponds to compulsory training required to be given to all workers under the H&S regulations. The course is devoted to in-depth analysis of the basic information and presentation of the general concepts regarding prevention of accidents and safety at work. It also includes typical information on the specific training for the majority of the jobs performed in the university, such as the use of equipment with video terminals and the procedures for dealing with emergencies.

Access course in ITALIAN ENGLISH

Course to access the Design Department Labs:

This six hours course focuses on specific safety contents to use the equipment of the Design Department Labs.

The training must include a two hours hands on session in the labs.

<u>Recipients</u>: teaching staff, contract professors, temporary research fellows, undergraduates and PhD students, technical-administrative personnel and collaborators.







This is necessary in order to record grades in your career.

Pay attention to deadlines:

- For **courses and laboratories**: exam registration opens approximately 1 month before each exam session and closes one week before the exam date.
- For workshops: registration will be open throughout the workshop's end.
 [Specific deadlines will be visible directly in the application].





Every time you need to access the Design Labs, you have to book via **Affluences** and bring your **personal badge**.




Lab access · Affluences

It supports experimental teaching, structures for exhibitions and events, and innovation in materials.



Lab Prototipi · prototypes

The Prototype Lab creates **models** and **prototypes** for design and industry, architecture, urban planning, and large-scale art installations.

It blends traditional craftsmanship with advanced technology, focusing on feasibility and cost-efficiency.



Lab Immagine · image

The Image Lab supports teaching and research in **audiovisual** and **photographic communication**, covering all phases from concept to post-production.

It features 1,000 m² of modular studio space equipped for professional photography and video in various sizes.



Lab Moda · fashion

The Fashion Lab specializes in **knitwear** and **tailoring**, equipped with various industrial sewing and cutting machines, knitting machines and other tools.

It enables students to work with diverse materials and techniques, supporting learning and industry research.


Language Courses






"Schiscetta" is the milanese word to indicate the lunchbox you prepare at home.
