

Registration for examinations

In order to sit an exam, it is mandatory to register for the session in which you intend to sit the exam; failure to register means that your grade cannot be recorded.

- Registration for an examination is permitted until 11.59 p.m. on the day of the call, but late registration requests (after the dates indicated by the application) are accepted at the sole discretion of the lecturer.
- Cancellation from an examination is permitted until 11.59 p.m. on the day preceding the roll call.

- Registration to an exam is permitted until 11.59 p.m on the day of the exam, but late registration (after the dates indicated by the application) are accepted at the discretion of the Professor.
- Cancellation from an exam is permitted until 11.59 p.m of the day before of the exam.



Results of the exams

The final evaluation that can be assigned at the end of tests are:

- **PASSED** (with a score expressed in thirtieths, minimum score 18/30, highest score 30/30 with honours)
- **POSTPONED (RM)** to the next exam date
- **REJECTED (RP)**, to a next exam session

Since Workshops and Studios have just one exam session at the end of the activity, the evaluation

- **postponed** or **rejected** implies the need to re-attend the class the following academic year.

Rejecting the grade:

- You will receive an e-mail stating your assessment (publication) and the deadline for requesting to see the written tests, to schedule an interview with the teacher and, if necessary, to reject the assessment.
- After this deadline, the assessment will be recorded and it will no longer be possible to retake the examination.

The Professor decides on how to register attendance.

The Weighted Average

What is it?

This is the average calculated on the **average of grades** and the number of **cfu passed**.

What is IMPORTANT for?

- To be allocated to elective courses according to one's preference
- Gain access to the Erasmus programme
- This is the starting point for calculating your graduation grade (with an impressive 28 you could achieve a 110 cum laude).

Courses Priority

All 1st year Studios (Laboratori) are prerequisite to the Final Synthesis Studio (LSF).

Students who have not passed one or more of the 1st year laboratories will not be able to include the Final Synthesis Studio and the credits (CFU) of the Final Examination in their study plan (i.e. their graduation will be postponed).



Training courses v. 2.5.0 / 2.5.0

• Basic Course on Safety:

Recipients: teaching staff, contract professors, temporary research fellows, undergraduates and PhD students, technical-administrative personnel and collaborators.

This course - lasting the equivalent of 4 hours - corresponds to compulsory training required to be given to all workers under the H&S regulations. The course is devoted to in-depth analysis of the basic information and presentation of the general concepts regarding prevention of accidents and safety at work. It also includes typical information on the specific training for the majority of the jobs performed in the university, such as the use of equipment with video terminals and the procedures for dealing with emergencies.

Admission to the Design Labs

From the 2025–26 academic year onwards, a **new Specific Training Course on Safety** will be **mandatory for accessing the Design Labs**. For new enrolments, the course is divided into three parts:

Part 1 – Online video Conference (VCS)

This is an online course on safety in the Design Department Laboratories and contains precise instructions for working safely in the Fashion, Prototypes and Exhibits, Image and Pilot LAB Laboratories. This course is available by reservation and appointment only. Bookings can be made via your personal page on the website www.polimi.it by following this path: Online Services > Booking spaces, lockers and other resources. Further details will be provided by email to interested parties

Part 2 - On Campus course (FSP)

This is a practical and demonstrative in-person course on working safely within the Design Department's laboratory spaces and with its technologies. It is available by reservation and dedicated appointment only (booking accessible from your personal page on the website www.polimi.it by following the path: Online Services > Booking spaces, lockers and other resources). It is only available after the user has completed part 1 with at least 80% attendance. Further details will be provided by email to interested parties.

Part 3 - Part 3 – Final assessment (on campus):

This is an end-of-course assessment consisting of 30 multiple-choice questions. It must be taken in person at the end of Part 2 on a personal device (laptop or mobile) and you must be identified using your university credentials. The test is passed by achieving a minimum score of 70%. Further details will be provided by email to interested parties

Those who already have the relevant qualifications will be able to access the laboratory facilities they have been trained in, while those who wish to access the DCC Pilot Lab will receive additional training.
